From Marie Abraham: Terrific example of understanding the strengths of your residents. We have to see people for who they are. Thank you. From Maria Warnell: One of the biggest challenges we've experienced is reaching the staff in the small, neighborhood residential care facilities. These homes do not have clinical staff. The staff they do have are kind and compassionate, but lack appropriate training for infection prevention and control. Back in May, we launched in-person education visits (outside), but many facilities were resistant to our visits. Connecting with the staff and making sure they know how to keep themselves and their residents safe is our biggest challenge.
